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### **COGNIVUE SCREENING OPTION**

Cognitive impairment is a growing concern. Memorial Hearing has made the decision to go beyond evaluating hearing in the traditional sense. Starting immediately, you will see a new **FDA approved** screening report called Cognivue.

- The screening is computerized and based on the same FDA cleared technology used by neurologists for cognitive assessment.
- It tests 3 key cognitive domains: visuospatial, memory, executive function and 2 performance parameters: speed processing and reaction time.
- Recent literature indicates that individuals with untreated hearing loss have a 55% greater risk
  of developing dementia when compared to those with normal hearing. (1,2,3)
- Hearing loss is the #1 modifiable risk factor for dementia and early intervention yields the best outcome. (4)

The data will be used to evaluate the impact of hearing devices to measure our patient outcomes. If there is hearing loss present, this data will also help your audiologist determine how your ability to hear speech in the presence of noise is impacted / can be helped.
